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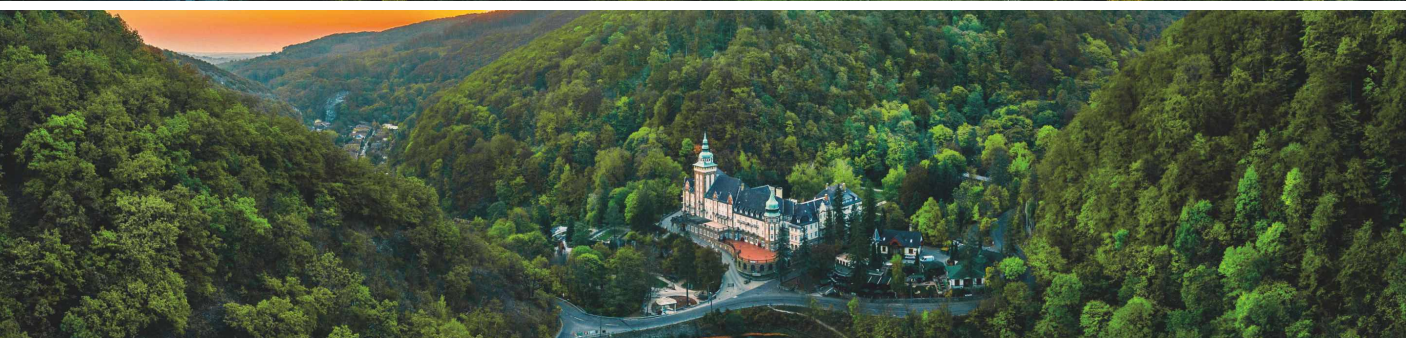
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ONE CITY, FOUR MOODS

DOWNTOWN

The city center is the scene of a lively cultural life.

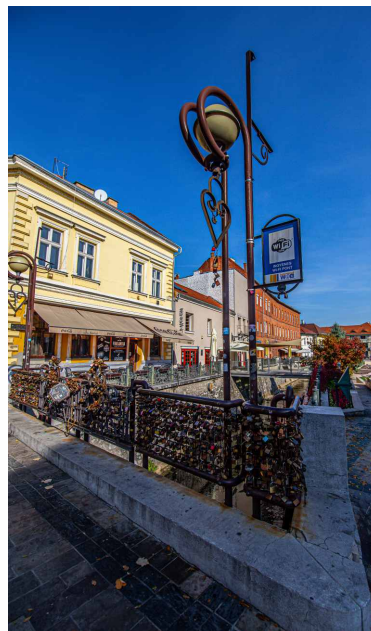
The downtown of Miskolc is colorful with cozy streets, fountain squares, architectural heritage, beautiful churches and unique places to eat.



One of the prominent players in the cultural life of the city is the almost 200-year-old National Theater of Miskolc, which was the first stone theater built in the territory of today's Hungary and performed in the Hungarian language.

Adjacent to the theater, the House of Arts offers entertainment opportunities not only for those interested in art, but also for lovers of lighter genres. Lovers of classical music can find a musical treat in the Music Palace. Among the exhibition spaces of the Herman Ottó Museum, the Rákóczi House of the Miskolc Gallery is located in the city center. Its exhibition not only presents the traditions of graphics and fine art life of Miskolc, which goes back more than a hundred years, but also presents current trends with its contemporary exhibitions. The Feledy House and the Petró House focus on important events in the local artistic life or on topics of local historical interest. In addition to presenting the history of acting in Miskolc, the much-loved Thália House is home to contemporary art exhibitions.

One of the most popular public spaces in downtown Miskolc, the Szinva terrace is full of fun and music on summer evenings. The romantic buildings and restaurants of Széchenyi Street welcome you on the terrace surrounded by food and drink bars with a Mediterranean atmosphere.

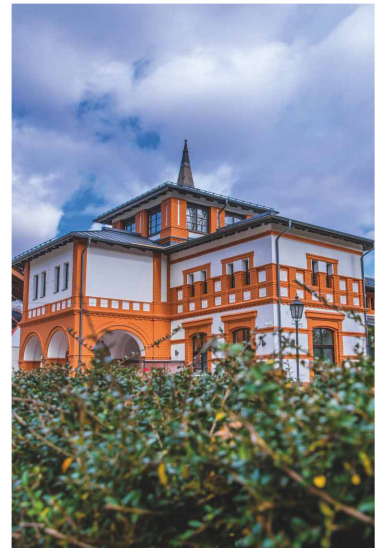




From whichever direction you come to Miskolc, the 234-meter-high Avas hill, rising above the historic city center, is already visible from afar and is an emblematic symbol of the city. Its beauty is the Gothic-style Avas Reformed Church, whose bell tower signals the passage of time with a unique melody that rings every quarter of an hour. Walking along the paths leading to the top of Avas reveals a completely different world, unique in Europe, there are more than 800 wine cellars in several rows located one above the other. The Avasi lookout offers a fantastic view of the city, and on a clear day you can even see the Zemplén Mountains and the peaks of the Tatras. The Horváth-tető Leisure Park, located next to the Avas Lookout Tower, popular place among young people.

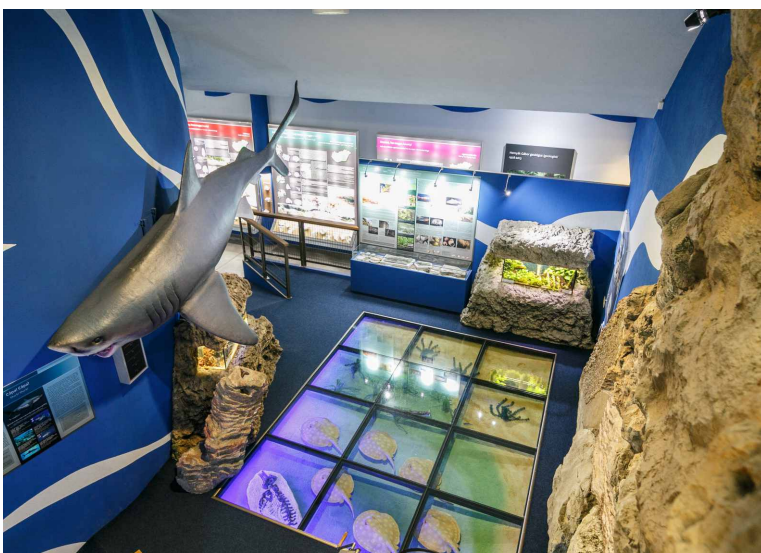


Népkert is the city's largest park with a contiguous green area, under whose huge trees, a tartan running track, an outdoor exercise park and cozy walkways await those who want to relax.





Opposite the Népkert is the Pannonian Sea Museum, where, in addition to the history of the research of the world-famous ancient trees discovered in Bükkábrány, visitors can discover the flora and fauna of our time in a playful, interactive way. This also includes the complete mineralogical exhibition of the Carpathian Basin, which is a mineral and rock presentation selected from 19,000 inventoried items.

MISKOLCTAPOLCA

Located a few kilometers from the city center, Miskolctapolca is an island of special spa experiences, relaxation and rejuvenation.

Miskolc's unique attraction is the Barlangfürdő (Cave Bath) of Miskolctapolca which has unique natural features even in European terms. The cave passages were carved out of the hard limestone rocks by natural karst water over thousands of years. It is an unforgettable experience to bathe in nature's covered swimming pool, in thermal water with a pleasant temperature coming from the depths of the mountain and enjoy the clean air.



The spa experience is completed by the indoor and outdoor pools, slides with VR glasses, wellness and fitness services of the Ellipsum Spa and Bath, which is open all year round.



The protected ancient park of Miskolctapolca beckons for a walk in every season.

At the lake, you can feed swans and wild ducks, go boating and even meet curious squirrels. The sacral monument visible in the square in front of the Cave Bath is the ruins of the church of the former Tapolca Benedictine abbey built in the 12th century.

This rotunda could have been the parish church of the settlement here, the earliest building in medieval Miskolc.

The children's favorite is the playground at the edge of the forest with fun slides and climbing frames. Families looking for adrenaline should also try the adventure park and the bobsleigh track.







MISKOLC-DIÓSGYŐR

Miskolc-Diósgyőr is a historical part of town that evokes the atmosphere of the Middle Ages.

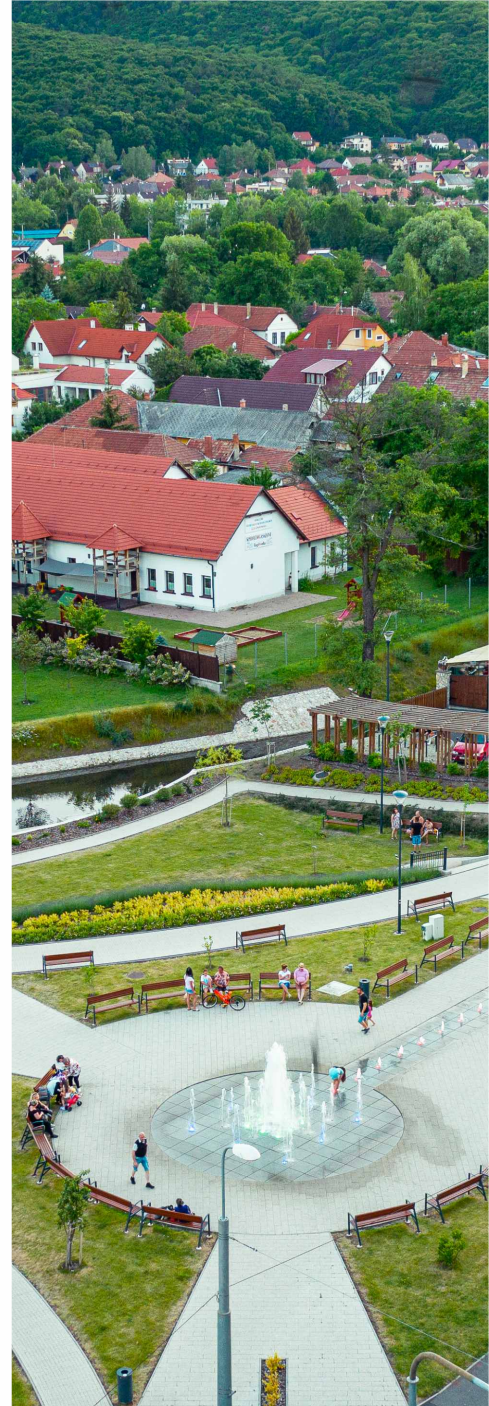
Walking along Vár utca under the beautiful chestnut trees, we reach Diósgyőr Castle, "the castle of the queens", an outstanding tourist attraction in Miskolc.



The Lovagi Tornák Tere (Equestrian Arena), built next to the castle, serves as a venue for traditional programs, sports events, concerts, fairs, open-air theater performances and public performances and community events.

Another emblematic symbol of Miskolc-Diósgyőr is the renewed DVTK stadium, where exciting football matches and competitions await sports fans.

The newest cozy corner of the Diósgyőr district is II. Pope János Pál square, where the sight of the Szinva stream and the fountain illuminated with colorful lights invite you to quiet contemplation.







MISKOLC-LILLAFÜRED

Miskolc-Lillafüred is a postcard come to life, with its natural wonders, the jewel of the wildly romantic Bükki landscape.

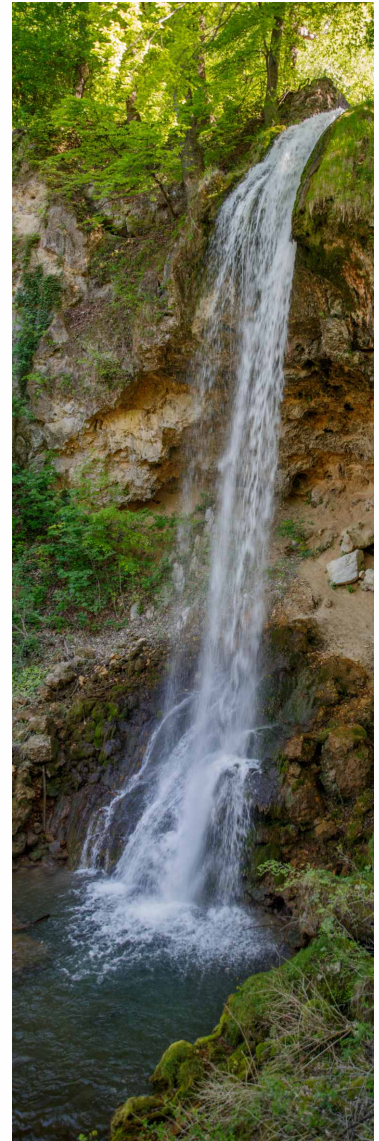
Certified as a climatic health resort, Lillafüred offers unforgettable experiences to hikers all year round. The district located in the picturesque surroundings is worth returning to in every season. A beautiful waterfall, adventurous nature trails, forest narrow-gauge railway, and boating allow complete relaxation.



The beautiful landscape also inspired Attila József: he wrote his well-known poem, the Ode, here. A full-length statue of the poet in the hanging garden of the Palotaszálló commemorates this.

Standing out from among the trees, the nearly 100-year-old Palotaszálló reminiscent of Renaissance castles awaits its guests with a wonderful view and exclusive services. Next to the hotel you can see Hámori lake with a fabulous atmosphere.

Another attraction of Lillafüred is the waterfall of Szinva stream, accessible through the Függekert, which is the highest waterfall in Hungary. In winter, in addition to the beauty of the snow-covered forest, the frozen waterfall dazzles visitors with an extraordinary sight.

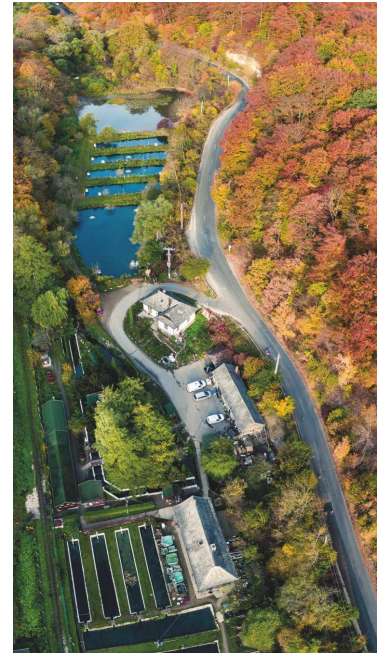


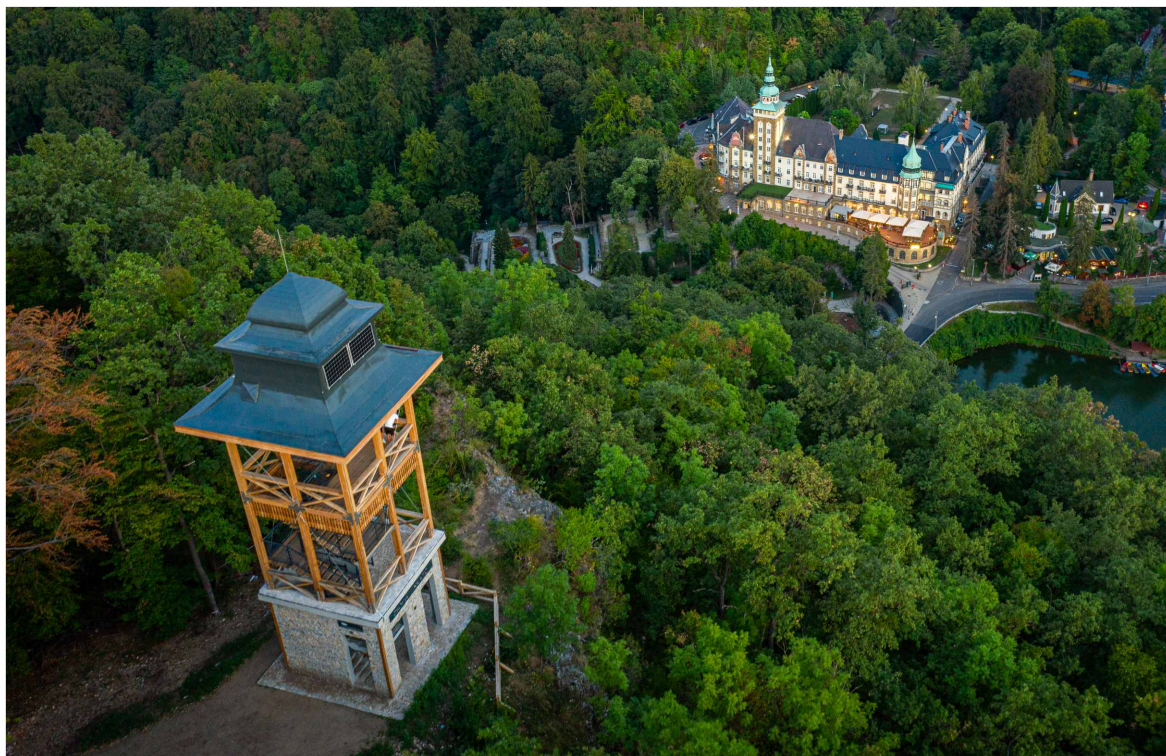
At the bottom of the waterfall is the Anna cave, which is a real rarity, there are only six limestone caves like it in the whole world.

If you are in the Garadna Valley, do not miss the Trout Farm. In the summer, it is also worth visiting the Erdei Halsütöde, where fresh, uniquely seasoned fried trout is served on your plate.

The Libegő (chairlift) in Lillafüred is a real adrenaline bomb for those who are not held back by vertigo. At the top of the ride above the trees of the forest, an unparalleled panorama opens up to travelers. In the valley of the Garadna stream, the Fazola smelter, also known as the old smelter, is connected to the name of Henrik Fazola, and next to it stands the Massa Museum and the historic iron forge, which provides an insight into the mysteries of iron processing at the time.

The polymath Herman Ottó, whose former summer house in Lillafüred, the Pele house, is now home to the Herman Ottó Memorial House.





The children's absolute favorite is the small train that runs through the trees of the Bükk Mountains all year round in one of the most beautiful areas of the country. From spring to autumn, passengers can travel in cozy, open cars, and in winter, they can travel in closed cars heated by stove. During the season of the Santa Claus Train, from the end of November to the middle of December, the surroundings of the station building in Lillafüred turn into a real fairytale world. For those who want to go hiking, we suggest the Zsófia Lookout Tower on the southern side of the Dolka Mountain, which offers a wonderful view of Hámor Valley.

The attraction of the Csanyik Valley is the Miskolc Zoo, which is home to nearly 120 species of animals. The zoo offers countless interesting and fun programs, from zoo daycare to show feeding.

CHURCHES AND CHURCH VALUES

The churches belonging to different denominations located in the city represent significant value not only from a sacred, but also from an architectural point of view.

Avas Reformed Monument Church

Among the monuments of Miskolc, the ancient church shines like a gem, next to it is the bell tower built in 1557. The church's organ, the famous Angster organ, is played every year by famous domestic and foreign organists. Next to the Gothic church is the oldest cemetery in Miskolc, where Bertalan Szemere and several members of the Latabár dynasty are buried.

Plank church

The Reformed church, decorated with impressive carvings, was built from the legacy of a famous merchant of the city. The building, which preserves Transylvanian architectural features, burned down in 1997, but thanks to a national effort, it was rebuilt.

Kakas (Rooster) Church

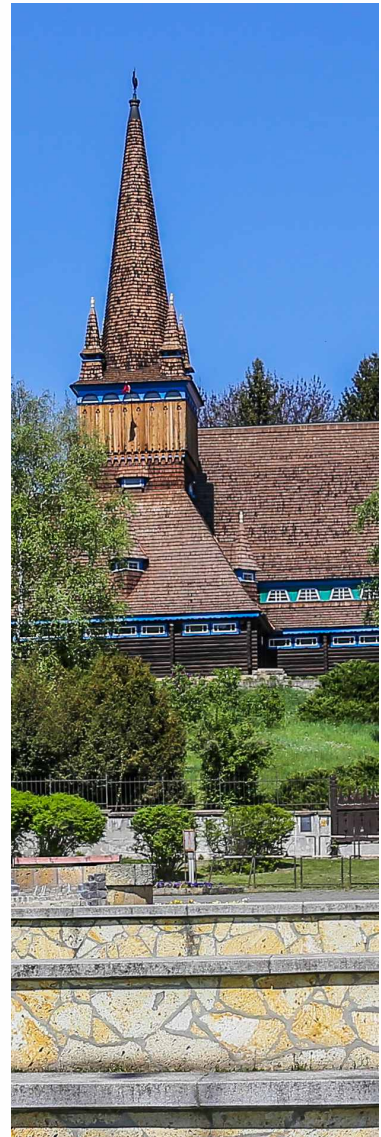
The special feature of the Belvárosi Reformed Church, or popularly known as Kakas Church, is the Eszter bell, the largest bell in the city and the county, which weighs nearly 6,613 pounds.

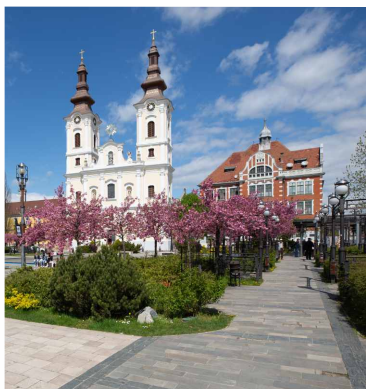

Mindszenti Church

The one-nave church decorated with eclectic towers, built in honor of the apostles St. Peter and St. Paul, is a prestigious work of the Baroque era, and it awaits its guests in a recently renewed form.

Minorite Church

The Minorite Parish Church of Our Lady is a dominant building of Hősök tere. On the left side stands the former Minorite monastery, now Kelemen Didák Boys' dormitory, on the right side the Földes Ferenc High School. *Kelemen Didák u. 3.*

Szentháromság (Holy Trinity) Orthodox Church

The famous creation of the interior is the five-story, 16-meter-high iconostasis consisting of 84 images. The building is one of the largest Greek Orthodox churches in Central Europe. *Deák tér 7.*

Downtown evangelical church

The 60-meter high tower of the 200-year-old church in the Luther courtyard is clearly visible from several points in the city center. Its organ was built in 1845, and the altarpiece was painted by Bertalan Székely. *Hunyadi utca 8.*

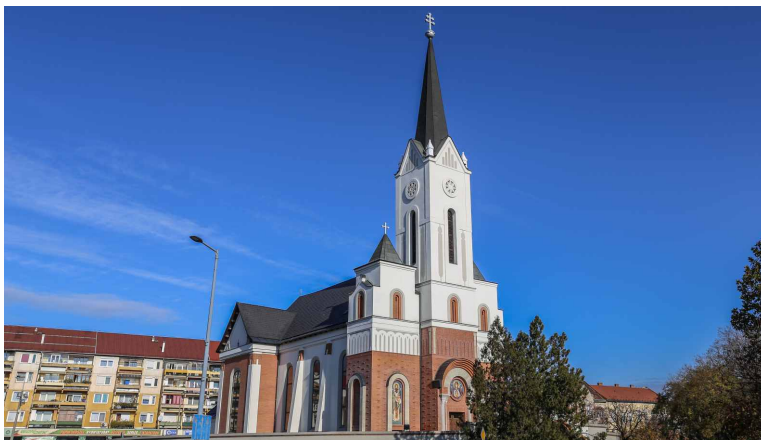
Synagogue

The Kazinczy Street Synagogue is the only synagogue in Miskolc, Borsod-Abaúj-Zemplén County and the region that is still operating today. Although the building cannot be visited currently due to renovation

works, the Miskolc Jewish Museum and Visitor Center located next to it welcomes those interested. *Kazinczy utca 7.*

Miskolc-Downtown Nagyboldogasszony (Our Lady) Greek Catholic Cathedral

The atmosphere of the beautifully renovated building, consecrated in 1911, mixes Western and Byzantine styles. The adornment of the single-nave interior is the richly decorated iconostasis consisting of 19 images. *Búza tér 1.*

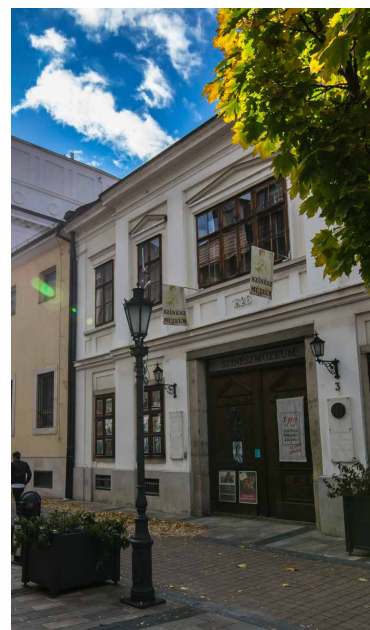
Thália House (Actors Museum)

Kocsonya Festival Miskolc

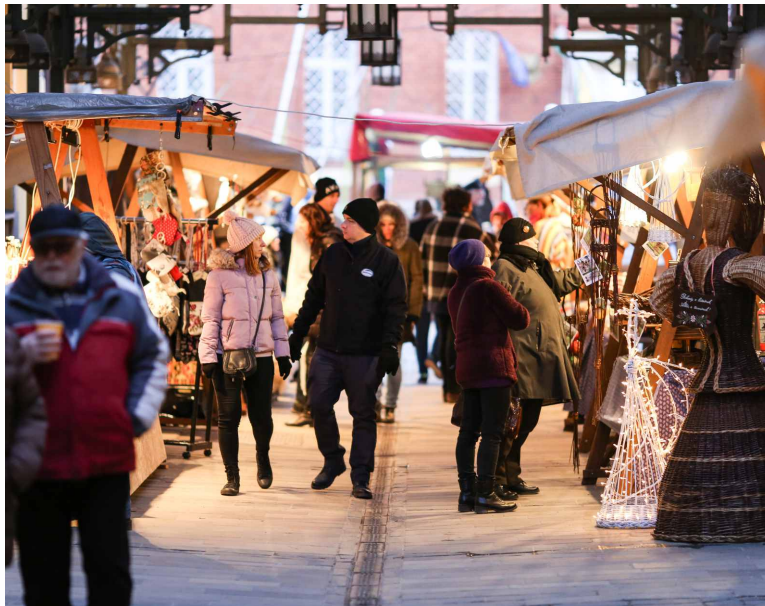

Miskolctapolca Barlangfürdő (Cave Bath)

Miskolc's internationally renowned attraction is the Cave Bath in Miskolctapolca. In the karst water cave system, which is unique in Europe, the indoor pools form a veritable labyrinth, where you can enjoy the pleasant massage of the current of wild water, while admiring the special forms of the natural formations.

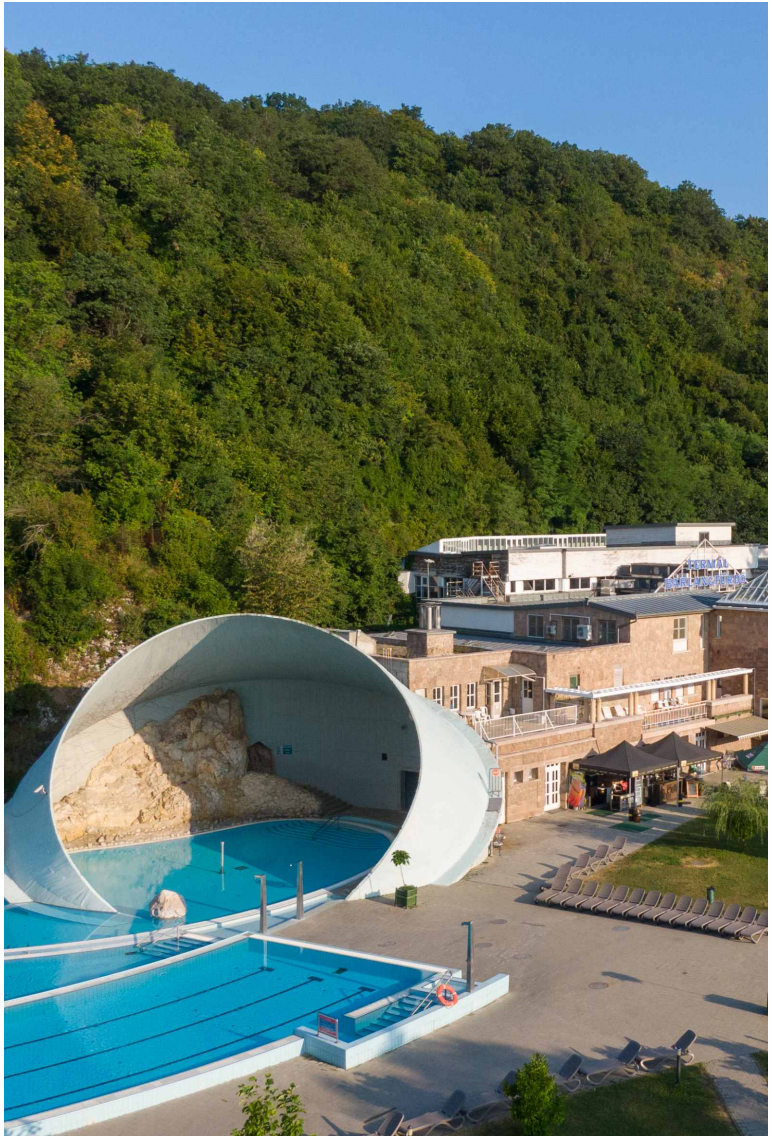
On the nearly 3.6-hectare landscaped beach area, the Barlangfürdő awaits its guests with a total of six pools rich in experience elements. By making the area barrier-free, trouble-free traffic is ensured even for people with reduced mobility. The salt content of the 30°C water is lower than that of the medicinal waters, so you can bathe in it for an unlimited time. The facility also includes a sauna park and a float spa (floating cabin).



Unmissable "cave" experiences are guaranteed by night bathing, foam parties and sauna sessions. What's more, there are programs even linked to the spa's annual maintenance break, during which guests can walk through the cave passages on a dry-foot tour.

Rest, healing and renewal are guaranteed by the services of the spa's aquatherapy section. The medical treatments, refreshing massages, detoxification, allergy and stress-relieving treatments perfectly meet the needs of guests who come with the intention of prevention, refreshment, and energy boost, and of all those who would like to reward themselves and their loved ones with a pleasant, pampering program.

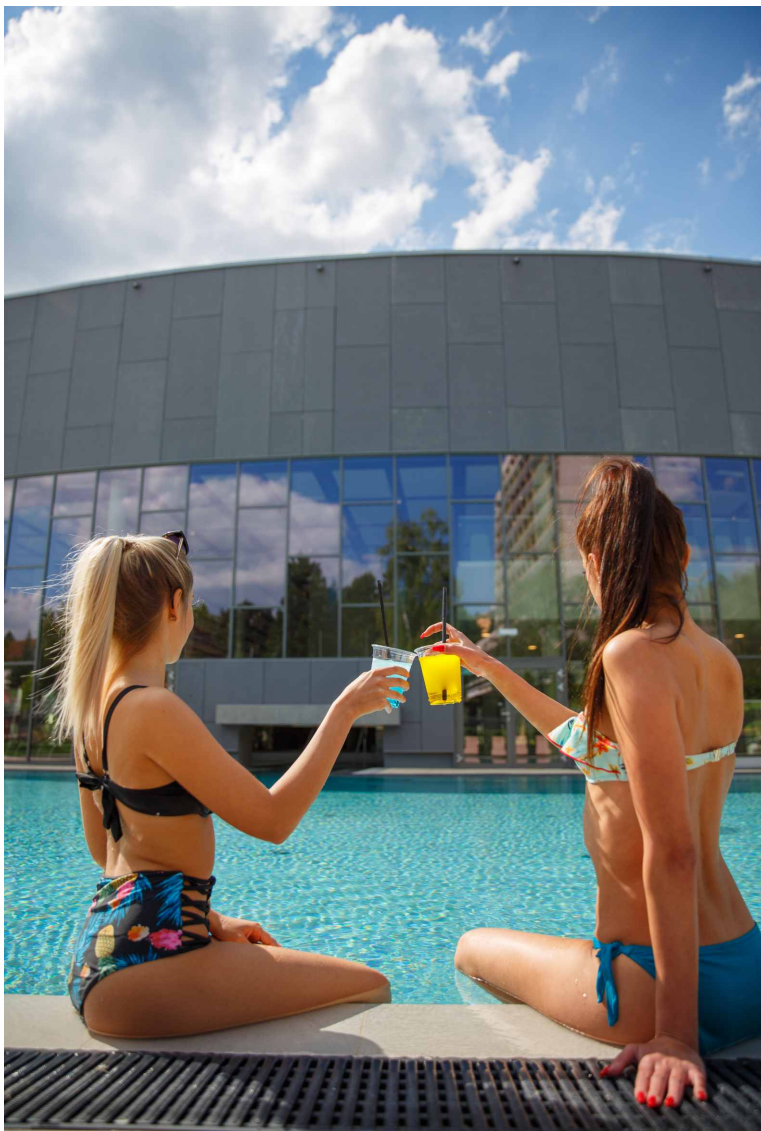


Elliptum Adventure and Outdoor Bath

In Lillafüred, the chairlift starting from the valley of the Szinva Stream transports passengers 1,080 meters long to the Jávör Mountain station located at an altitude of 606 meters.
